- 5) the selling of goods in short supply at inflated prices
- 6) Treaty that ended the Seven Years War giving England almost all land east of the Mississippi River
- 7) dumping of 18,000 pounds of tea into Boston Harbor by colonists in 1773 to protest the Tea Act
- 8) a 1765 law in which Parliament established the first direct taxation of goods and services within the British colonies in North America
- 9) colonists who supported American Independence from Britain
- 10) document in which the delegates of the 2nd Continental Congress declared the colonies' independence from Britain
- 11) pamphlet written by Thomas Paine, published in 1776, that called for separation of the colonies from Britain
- 13) clash between British soldiers and Boston colonists, in which five of the colonists were killed
- 15) a series of laws enacted by Parliament to punish Massachusetts colonists for the Boston Tea Party
- 16) the belief that all people should have equal political, economic, social and civil rights

- 4) Patriot civilian soldiers just before and during the Revolutionary War, pledged to be ready to fight at a minute's notice
