Sons of Liberty Form		1) British soldiers fell by the dozen to the guerilla tactics of the minutemen 2) An armed clash erupted 3) promised the colonies would fight back against British if force is used 4) authorized the printing of a Continental Currency – their own money – to pay the soldiers
Boston Massacre		5) offered the Olive Branch Petition to King George III 6) 56 delegates from the colonies met in Philadelphia 7) the deadliest battle of the Revolutionary War
Boston Tea Party		8) harassed customs workers, stamp agents, and royal governors (when necessary) 9) to disperse the militiamen, General Gage struck out at militiamen camped on hills overlooking Boston 10) the colonists won the hill but the British lost more soldiers
First Continental Congress		11) based on the enlightenment ideas of John Locke 12) after a fist fight between colonists & poorly paid British soldiers, a mob gathered outside the Customs House that taunted the guards 13) Crispus Attucks and 4 others are the first civilian deaths at the hands of British soldiers
Battle of Lexington & Concord		14) a protest of the tea Act 15) successful in preventing the Stamp Act from going into effect 16) a secret resistance group to protest Stamp Act and other perceived liberties
Second Continental Congress		17) formed the Stamp Act Congress 18) considered the start of the American Revolution 19) declared support for protests in Massachusetts 20) laid out the logical explanation as to why the colonies had declared independence
Battle of Bunker Hill		21) written by Thomas Jefferson 22) British troops were ambushed on the road back to Boston by some 3,000 – 4,000 minutemen all the way 23) adopted July 4, 1776
Declaration of Independence		24) decided the colonies have the right to run their own affairs 25) British troops were sent to seize and destroy all munitions possible 26) as the colonists were backing down at the command of the British, a shot was fired and the British fired back killing 8 minutemen and injuring 10 more
		27) recognized the militiamen as the Continental Army and placed George Washington as their commander 28) colonists disguised as Native Americans, dumped 18,000 pounds of East Indian Company tea into Boston Harbor
