- 1) ensures suffrage to all people regardless of race
- 3) system in which landowners give farm workers land, seed, and tools in return for a part of the crops they raise
- 6) Southern Democrats' term for their return to power in the South in the 1870s
- 7) secret organization that used terrorist tactics in an attempt to restore white supremacy in Southern states after the Civil War
- 8) makes all persons born or naturalized in the US, including former slaves, citizens of the country and guarantees equal protection of the laws
- 9) congressional Republicans who wanted to destroy the power of former slaveholders and give African Americans full citizenship and the right to vote
- 12) the period of rebuilding that followed after the Civil War, during which the defeated Confederate states were readmitted to the Union
- 13) Northerner who moved to the South after the Civil War
- 14) in the South, post-Civil War laws restricting African Americans' lives
