How to be a close reader:

- 1) Skim for unfamiliar words (Tier I words) (circle) and write them in the margin or space to the right.
- 2) Read the paragraph/text
 - a) using context clues, try to define the unfamiliar words you circled
 - b) annotate annotate annotate
 - c) In the left and right margins is where your thinking shows. Write comments, ideas, definitions that you realize or figure out as you read.
